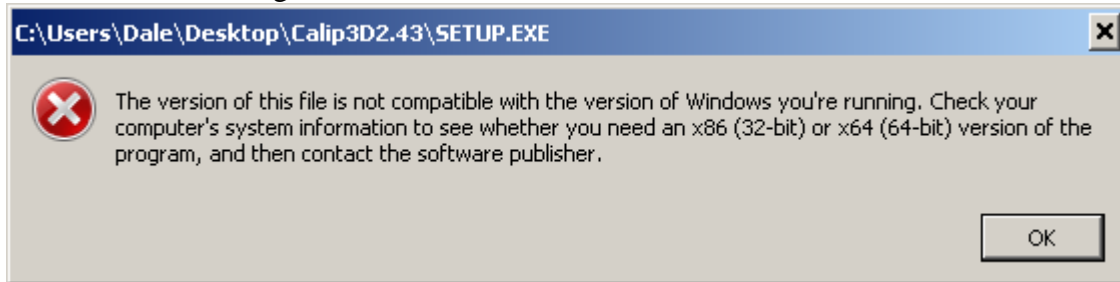

-Ran as Admin and Changed Compatability options with no help

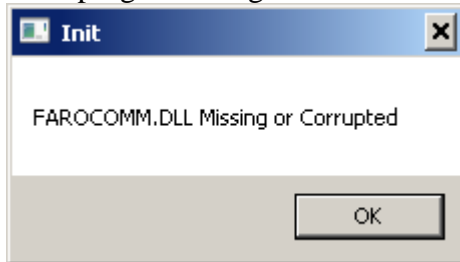
-Get this error message:

-Run program and get this error message:



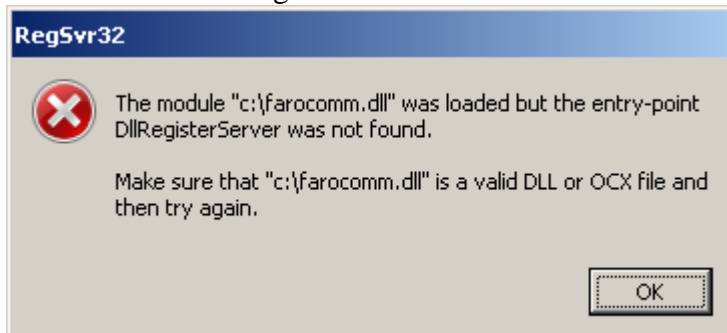
-Copied farocomm.dll to c:\

-Get this error message:



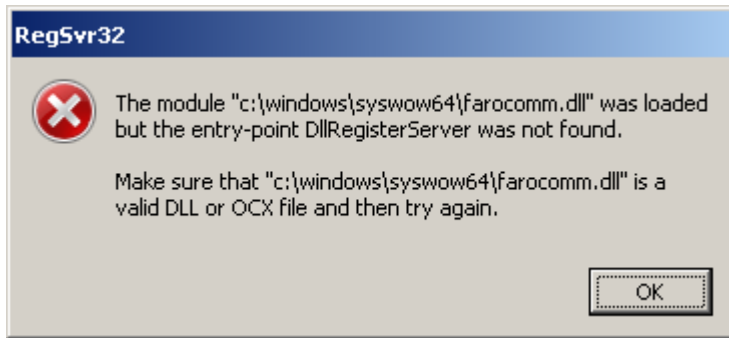
-Copied farocomm.dll to c:\windows\syswow64

### ----- **Installing 32bit program in Win764**

-Will not install, error message "not compatible with the version of windows"
